

Constructing a Sports Stadium Using Shapes

Materials needed – pencil (for tracing), construction paper, scissors, glue stick and cardboard (optional)

Step 1: Identify which stadium you would like to build.

Step 2: Using colored construction paper, cut out the shapes you think you will need. For example, diamond shapes, triangles, squares and rectangles can be used to create a stadium. You can find templates of these shapes online to trace and cut, or draw them free hand.

Step 3: Arrange shapes how you would like them on your paper. Placing shapes first to build the stadium is suggested. When pleased with the arrangement, then go back and glue each shape to the paper/cardboard.

Step 4: Give your stadium a name. Ask a friend or relative to try and locate all the shapes you used and name them!
