

FOOD CUPBOARD

For Delaware County residents, delivers urgently needed food to low-income community residents. Eligible households receive food packages one Thursday per month. Each food package provides breakfast, lunch and dinner. Food packages may also be distributed on an emergency or one-time basis for any community household in need.


Food packages contain such items as fresh vegetables and fruit, dairy items, eggs, canned goods, bakery goods and pastries, cereals, poultry, fish and meat. When available, infant foods dietary supplements are distributed. All products distributed meet the nutritional guidelines/requirements established by the U.S. Department of Agriculture.

The food cupboard is open Thursdays 6:00pm to 8:00 pm. To register, you must present identification.

Your First Visit

When you arrive you will sign in with the registration desk. You will receive a white paper with a number on it. Fill out that form and keep it with you. When your number is called, an interviewer will ask you for information. For your first visit, please bring with you:

- *VALID Photo ID (must be within the last 3 months)
- *Proof of CURRENT Address. Examples: Lease, Bill, Letter with your name on it.)
- *Social Security or Medical Card for all living in the home.

(You need to provide this once a year.)

Pennsylvania Clearances are FREE for volunteers! There are 2 Different Clearances for PA

- PA Criminal History Clearance (PA STATE POLICE)
- PA Child Abuse Clearance




3rd clearance is needed but only if you have lived outside of PA within the last 10 years. This clearance requires you to go to Identogo to get fingerprinted and costs \$23.85

If you have lived in PA for the past 10 years or more, you may complete and sign the Disclosure Statement (Affidavit) provided by the district! Your clearances will be good for 5 years

HOW DO I DO ALL OF THIS?

All of the information you need can be found in the "FOR PARENTS" section of your school's website. Select your child's school, Click on FOR PARENTS, and Select Volunteer Requirements (if you cannot see the option to select a school and you are sing a mobile device, which to Desktop Version in your browser)
